





SAL LAGANO • 17TH SEASON • HOFSTRA '88



Sal Lagano was hired as the head coach of NYIT's men's basketball program in 1997. Over the past 15 years, he has built the team into one of the top programs in the East Coast Conference (ECC).

Under his tutelage, the Bears have won one ECC championship and earned the program's first NCAA Tournament bid in more than 20 years. Several Bears, including all-time leading points scorer Bryant Lassiter and All-NYCAC standout Manix Auriantal, have gone on to

have successful careers playing in leagues in Puerto Rico, Canada, China, and Hungary. Kirk Stewar and Lassitier have also spent seasons with the world famous Harlem Globetrotters.

Lagano has also provided the men's program with experiences that go beyond NCAA Division II basketball as the Bears have played exhibition games against Division I opponents, including Manhattan College in 2006-2007, Iona College in 2005-2006, Hofstra for three consecutive seasons (2002-2005), LIU-Brooklyn in 2007-2008, and Villanova in 2011-2012. In 2010-2011, for the second time during his tenure, the Bears traveled to Montreal, Canada, for a pre-season tune-up tour that included three exhibition games in three nights.

Last season, NYIT finished second in the ECC with a 13-5 mark and went 19-10 on the season. The Bears earned a first round bye in the conference tournament but fell to Dowling in the semifinals 85-67. Both Dominic Scurry and Kayvon Roberts reached the 1,000-point milestone with Roberts and Phil Izevbehai earning All-ECC honors.

The Bears finished the 2011-2012 season .500 in ECC play (8-8) and 11-15 overall after falling to the Golden Lions of Dowling in the league playoffs. Rookies Jahleel Felix and Nick Fessenden made quite an impression during their first season at NYIT and became the program's first ECC All-Rookie selections. Roberts paced the Bears with 14.8 points per game, while junior Azel Prather Jr averaged a team-best and was second in the ECC with 7.9 rebounds per game.

In 2010-2011, NYIT advanced to the conference semifinals after posting a 13-15 overall record and a 10-11 ECC mark. Roberts earned All-ECC first team honors for his performance that included a first career double-double of 22 points and 11 rebounds against Queens (N.Y.) on Feb. 9, 2011.

In 2009-2010, the Bears finished one game under .500 (14-16, 10-11 ECC) and fell to Bridgeport in the conference playoffs. Jerrell Walker earned All-ECC second team honors for his performance, while Scurry was named to the All-Rookie team and Carl Kindborg earned ECC Scholar-Athlete Honor Roll accolades.

In 2008-2009, NYIT faced only its fourth losing season under Lagano's direction with an 13-15 overall mark and an 8-10 finish in the ECC. It was the second time the Bears did not advance to the conference playoffs. Bryant Lassiter earned All-ECC and All-Met second team honors after leading NYIT with 17.3 points per game, 41 steals, and 113 assists. The previous season, 2007-2008, marked Lagano's 10th year with the Bears, and NYIT rocked the ECC with a 13-7 mark.

In 2006-2007, Lagano led NYIT to a 20-9 record, 15-5 in the ECC, and captured the first-ever ECC regular-season championship in team history. For the program, it was just the fifth 20-win season and Lagano's second 20-win season in four years. Prior to the 2005-2006 season, in which the Bears suffered through a 5-22 rebuilding process, NYIT advanced to the conference tournament for seven straight seasons and had a combined record of 73-46 overall, including 61-33 during a four-year stretch and a top 10 ranking in the region.

In 2003-04, NYIT advanced to its first NCAA tournament appearance in more than 20 years. During that year, Lagano was named the Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association (MBWA) Coach of the Year as he guided NYIT to 22 victories, its fourth 20-win season.

In 1997, Lagano inherited a team with a 9-17 record, and the Bears suffered through a 3-25 season during his first year as head coach. But the program rebounded nicely to finish its 1998-1999 campaign with a 14-14 record. The season was highlighted with a victory over nationally ranked Adelphi that broke a 13-year losing streak. The Bears also advanced to the NYCAC playoffs for the first time in two years; and, for the first time since 1994, the Bears were invited back to the Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference post-season tournament.

NYIT hovered around the .500 mark for three seasons before finally breaking free in 2001-2002 when it finished with an 18-14 record. The Bears advanced to their first NYCAC tournament championship game after defeating top-seeded Adelphi in the semifinals. Although they lost in the finals, the Bears were no longer at the bottom of league. In 2002-2003, NYIT finished with a 17-11 record and was ranked ninth in the Northeast Region, just missing out on an invitation to the NCAA tournament.

Before his appointment at NYIT, Lagano was the head coach at Suffolk West Community College for three seasons, 1994-1997, and he experienced much success there as well. Just one season after taking over, Lagano led that team to a 17-12 record, the best in school history. The improvement would not stop as Suffolk-West bettered its record to 23-11 in the 1996-97 season, appeared in the Region XV championship game for the first time in its program's history, and defeated two-time defending Junior College Division III champion Sullivan Community College twice. During his tenure, Lagano coached the only two Junior College All-Americans in school history.

Lagano got his start in coaching in 1988 when he was hired as the junior varsity coach at St. Anthony's High School in South Huntington, N.Y. After two seasons, Lagano became an assistant on the varsity coaching staff, where he remained for three seasons before moving over to Suffolk-West. He was hired as an assistant for the 1993-1994 season and became the head coach the next season. Over the years, he has worked countless summer basketball camps, including Eastern Invitational, Hofstra University, Villanova, and Rick Pitino's camp at St. Dominic's High School.

Lagano received his bachelor's degree in social sciences from Hofstra in 1988. He has been a teacher of physical education and health at St. Anthony's High School since 1990. In 1997, Lagano earned his master's degree in school administration from the College of New Rochelle. He lives in Melville, N.Y. with his wife, Kathy, and their daughter, Alexandra.

31 Years

Clyde Doughty, Jr. has been at NYIT for 37 years, since the day he first attended a class at the Old Westbury campus (1976). A native of Hollis, Queens, New York, Doughty attended Brooklyn Technical High School, where he played three seasons of varsity basketball.

He earned a scholarship to NYIT and during his basketball career, the Bears made it to the NCAA Tournament twice, losing in the championship game to Virginia Union in 1979-80. After graduating, Doughty became the academic advisor to student-athletes, and three years later, he became the Assistant Director of Athletics. In 1988, he succeeded Dr. William T. Lai as Director of Athletics.

Doughty currently oversees intercollegiate, recreational and intramural athletic programs at the Old Westbury and Manhattan campuses. He counts among his achievements enhancing the athletics department's organizational structure and stability, and improving the academic performances of NYIT's student-athletes. During Doughty's tenure, the Bears have made numerous appearances in NCAA and ECAC post-season play. The men's lacrosse team has won the NCAA National championship four times, 1997, 2003, 2005 and 2008, the ECAC Championship in 2001 and appeared in the NCAA championship game on two other occasions, 1994 and 2002. The men's basketball team captured the ECAC championship in 1995, while the men's track and field

placed third at the NCAA Division II Outdoor Track and Field Championships in 1999 and second at the indoor championships in 2001.

Doughty, who earned a bachelor's degree in business management, has two master's degrees from NYIT: one in human resource management and one in human relations.

Doughty has served as chair of the Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference's men's basketball committee, the men's basketball chair of the New York Collegiate Athletic Conference, and was a member of the NCAA's Northeast Men's Basketball Regional Committee for three years. He was president of the NYCAC from 1994 through 1997, and was a member of the ECAC's Executive Council from 1989 until 1992.

In January 2001, Doughty was named to a four-year term as a member of the NCAA Division II Management Council. The council implements policies adopted by the NCAA Executive Committee and the Presidents' Council, interprets Division II bylaws, and recommends the adoption of amendments and regulations regarding Division II athletics. In 2013, he was appointed to a second term as a member of the Division II Management Council.

As part of his Management Council responsibilities, Doughty has served on two project teams and has been a member of the committees on budget and finance, championships, the Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC), the honors committee, and nominations committee.

In 2004, Doughty was selected by the National Athletic Directors Association (NACDA) as the Division II Northeast Region Athletic Director of the Year.

Doughty currently serves on the NCAA Student-Athlete Advisory Group within the student affairs division. The group supports NCAA staff in the areas of education programs, health and safety and leadership development. Since 2009, Doughty has also served as the master of ceremonies for the NCAA Career in Sports Forum.

During his tenure, Doughty has assisted in the development and implementation of the Bears Den fundraising club, the establishment of the Athletic Hall of Fame, the annual Bears Golf Outing, the Athletic Directors Honor roll, the BEARS mentor educational program, the Senior Awards banquet, the Bears Care Community Service program, and the Night Out on The Bears community engagement program.

"I am honored that I have been able to sustain a very fruitful career at NYIT," he says. "I have been blessed to work with great individuals who have taken the time to help me mature as an administrator, mentor, parent, and human being."

Doughty resides in Wheatley Heights, NY, with his wife, Pamela, his mother, Ida, and three children: 33-year-old Brandon, 25-year-old Jessica, and 21-year-old Andre.

DIRECTIONS TO NYIT

BY CAR

FROM THE WEST:

Long Island Expressway (I-495) to exit 39N (Glen Cove Road). Follow Glen Cove Road north to Northern Blvd. (Route 25 A). Turn right onto Northern Blvd. and head east. The NYIT entrance is the third traffic signal on your right.

FROM THE EAST:

LIE (I-495) to exit 41N (Route 107). Go north (toward Glen Cove) on Rte. 107 to Northern Blvd. (Route 25A). Turn left onto Northern Blvd. and continue west for four traffic lights. Make a left into NYIT's main entrance at the fourth traffic light.

FROM THE SOUTH SHORE:

Take either the Meadowbrook, Cross Island or Wantagh Parkways north to the Northern State Parkway, exit 31. Make a left at light, proceed north on Glen Cove Road until you reach Northern Blvd. and follow the above directions.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:

The Long Island Rail Road provides access at several stations: Hicksville, Manhasset and Greenvale (closest to campus). The Metropolitan Transit Authority's Route N20 bus, which travels from Main Street in Flushing to the Hicksville train station via Northern Blvd. stops adjacent to the main entrance of the campus.
