CHRIS FRUSCI • SECOND SEASON • MUHLENBERG '08



Chris Frusci was named head men's and women's tennis coach in October 2011. He previously served as assistant coach to both programs in 2010-2011 and took over the reigns as interim head coach in the summer of 2011.

In his first season at the helm, NYIT earned its first trip to the NCAA Tournament with an 11-12 overall record and a 2-2 East Coast Conference (ECC) mark, which was good for third place. The Bears were led by ECC Rookie of the Year Pedro Peixoto, who finished the season 17-11 in singles play and 15-11 in doubles. Dustin Wenchel also earned All-ECC honors. Academically, sophomore Julian Marcon posted his fourth straight 4.0 grade-point average for a semester and earned CoSIDA At-Large Academic All-District I honors.

On the women's side, Frusci guided the Bears to their first ECC Championship in fall 2012 as the Bears went 14-1 and 6-1 in league action. For his efforts, Frusci was named ECC Coach of the Year, while graduate student Nelly Ciolkowski earned ECC Player of the Year honors. Ciolkowski won the Intercollegiate Tennis Association (ITA) East Regional and finished fifth at the USTA/ITA Small College Nationals in Mobile, Ala.

In 2011, the women's team produced a spectacular turnaround from a 1-10 record in 2010 to a 9-6 overall regular-season record and a 4-2 mark in the East Coast Conference, which was good for third place. NYIT was paced by ECC Rookie of the Year Sara Burinato, who also won the ITA East Regional and finished fifth at the USTA/ITA Small College Nationals in Mobile, Ala. Also earning All-ECC honors was Rocío Benavent and Gaby Rodriguez. Burinato and Rodriguez also represented the East Region at the Small College Nationals, where they finished seventh overall.

A Lynbrook, N.Y., native, Frusci received his B.S. in business administration with a concentration in marketing from Muhlenberg in 2008. He was the No. 1 recruited player from the Mules football team's class of 2008. Unfortunately, Frusci was dealt a career-ending shoulder injury and only played one season.

A three-sport athlete at Lynbrook, Frusci lettered in football, basketball, and baseball. As a senior, he received all-county football honors, all-conference basketball accolades, and was named all-division for baseball. Frusci was also voted MVP of the Senior Bowl for football. Throughout his academic career, he earned honor roll and dean's list accolades.



## OUR GOAL

New York Institute of Technology (NYIT) is committed to developing student-athletes and building strong relationships with local communities by engaging in community service programs that:

The New York Institute of Technology Department of Intercollegiate Athletics and Recreation received an East Coast Conference Community Engagement Award of Excellence for the third annual "Night Out on the Bears" event. The award is presented annually to an institution that hosts an activity on its campus that embodies the principles of community engagement by building relationships and bridging the gap between campus and community.



**Clyde M. Doughty Jr.**  
**31 Years**

Clyde Doughty, Jr., actually has been at NYIT for 35 years, since the day he first attended a class at the Old Westbury campus (1976). A native of Hollis, Queens, New York, Doughty attended Brooklyn Technical High School, where he played three seasons of varsity basketball.

He earned a scholarship to NYIT and during his basketball career, the Bears made it to the NCAA Tournament twice, losing in the championship game to Virginia Union in 1979-80. After graduating, Doughty became the academic advisor to student-athletes, and three years later, he became the Assistant Director of Athletics. In 1988, he succeeded Dr. William T. Lai as Director of Athletics.

Doughty currently oversees intercollegiate, recreational and intramural athletic programs at the Old Westbury and Manhattan campuses. He counts among his achievements enhancing the athletics department's organizational structure and stability, and improving the academic performances of NYIT's student-athletes. During Doughty's tenure, the Bears have made numerous appearances in NCAA and ECAC post-season play. The men's lacrosse team has won the NCAA National championship four times, 1997, 2003, 2005 and 2008, the ECAC Championship in 2001 and appeared in the NCAA championship game on two other occasions, 1994

and 2002. The men's basketball team captured the ECAC championship in 1995, while the men's track and field placed third at the NCAA Division II Outdoor Track and Field Championships in 1999 and second at the indoor championships in 2001.

Doughty, who earned a bachelor's degree in business management, has two master's degrees from NYIT: one in human resource management and one in human relations.

Doughty has served as chair of the Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference's men's basketball committee, the men's basketball chair of the New York Collegiate Athletic Conference, and was a member of the NCAA's Northeast Men's Basketball Regional Committee for three years. He was president of the NYCAC from 1994 through 1997, and was a member of the ECAC's Executive Council from 1989 until 1992.

In January 2001, Doughty was named to a four-year term as a member of the NCAA Division II Management Council. The council implements policies adopted by the NCAA Executive Committee and the Presidents' Council, interprets Division II bylaws, and recommends the adoption of amendments and regulations regarding Division II athletics.

As part of his Management Council responsibilities, Doughty has served on two project teams and has been a member of the committees on budget and finance, championships, the Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC) and the honors committee.

In 2004, Doughty was selected by the National Athletic Directors Association (NACDA) as the Division II Northeast Region Athletic Director of the Year.

Doughty currently serves on the NCAA Student-Athlete Advisory Group within the student affairs division. The group supports NCAA staff in the areas of education programs, health and safety and leadership development.

During his tenure, Doughty has assisted in the development and implementation of the Bears Den fundraising club, the establishment of the Athletic Hall of Fame, the annual Bears Golf Outing, the Athletic Directors Honor roll, the BEARS mentor educational program, the Senior Awards banquet, the Bears Care Community Service program, and the Night Out on The Bears community engagement program.

"I am honored that I have been able to sustain a very fruitful career at NYIT," he says. "I have been blessed to work with great individuals who have taken the time to help me mature as an administrator, mentor, parent, and human being."

Doughty resides in Wheatley Heights, NY, with his wife, Pamela, his mother, Ida, and three children: 31-year-old Brandon, 24-year-old Jessica, and 19-year-old Andre.

## DIRECTIONS TO NYIT

### BY CAR

#### FROM THE WEST:

Long Island Expressway (I-495) to exit 39N (Glen Cove Road). Follow Glen Cove Road north to Northern Blvd. (Route 25 A). Turn right onto Northern Blvd. and head east. The NYIT entrance is the third traffic signal on your right.

#### FROM THE EAST:

LIE (I-495) to exit 41N (Route 107). Go north (toward Glen Cove) on Rte. 107 to Northern Blvd. (Route 25A). Turn left onto Northern Blvd. and continue west for four traffic lights. Make a left into NYIT's main entrance at the fourth traffic light.

#### FROM THE SOUTH SHORE:

Take either the Meadowbrook, Cross Island or Wantagh Parkways north to the Northern State Parkway, exit 31. Make a left at light, proceed north on Glen Cove Road until you reach Northern Blvd. and follow the above directions.

#### PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:

The Long Island Rail Road provides access at several stations: Hicksville, Manhasset and Greenvale (closest to campus). The Metropolitan Transit Authority's Route N20 bus, which travels from Main Street in Flushing to the Hicksville train station via Northern Blvd. stops adjacent to the main entrance of the campus.
