## STEVE CHRISTIANSON • 7TH SEASON • ST. CLOUD '99



Since taking over the reigns in 2007, NYIT head coach Stephen Christianson has transformed the softball program into one of the top contenders in the East Coast Conference and the Northeast Region. In 2009, Christianson led the Bears to a record 37 wins and the program's first appearance in the ECC tournament championship game.

Christianson looks to get the program back on track after back-to-back injury plagued seasons. In 2012, the Bears more than doubled their 2011 wins total, posting a 12-33 overall record. In 2011, NYIT went 5-35.

In 2010, the Bears finished with their second consecutive 30-win season with a 33-23 record. Despite going 37-24-1 in 2009, the Bears just missed out on their second consecutive trip to the NCAA tournament. Christianson also earned his 100th career coaching victory with a 9-4 win over St. Thomas Aquinas on April 14, 2009. In 2008, he led NYIT to one of the most successful seasons in the program's history, as the Bears finished with a 29-18 record, were ranked as high as fourth in the Northeast region, and received their first bid to the NCAA tournament. Their achievements over the past three seasons have been recognized with votes in the 2009 and 2010 National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) Division II national poll.

In his first season at the helm of the program in 2007, Christianson inherited a team that was 13-22 the season before and orchestrated a 20-20 record, which included an appearance in the ECC tournament.

Christianson came to NYIT from The Baseball Center New York City, where he served as head baseball and softball instructor.

Prior to The Baseball Center, Christianson was associate director of athletics and head softball coach at Trinity University in Washington, D.C. In 2006, he was named Atlantic Women's Colleges Conference (AWCC) Softball Coach of the Year. In his two seasons at Trinity, Christianson coached four student-athletes to first team all-conference selections and four to second team all-conference selections, as well as one student-athlete to an all-conference honorable mention selection. In 2005, he guided one team member to AWCC Newcomer of the Year and Most Outstanding Player honors.

Before coaching at Trinity, Christianson coached the nationally recognized softball program at Bishop Denis J. O'Connell High School in Arlington, Va., where he served as head junior varsity coach of the undefeated Washington Catholic Athletic Conference championship team. Previously, he coached at St. Agnes High School in St. Paul, Minn., where he led the softball team to consecutive Tri-Metro Conference championships in 2001 and 2002.

Christianson resides in Mineola, N.Y., with son Gunnar and daughter Madeline. In 1999, Christianson earned a B.S. in elementary education from St. Cloud State University. He has taught at several softball and baseball clinics focusing on hitting, pitching, catching, base running, and conditioning. Christianson is a member of the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) and NFCA Division II Softball Head Coaches Committee.



## Clyde M. Doughty Jr. 31 Years at NYIT

Clyde Doughty, Jr., actually has been at NYIT for 36 years, since the day he first attended a class at the Old Westbury campus (1976). A native of Hollis, Queens, New York, Doughty attended Brooklyn Technical High School, where he played three seasons of varsity basketball.

He earned a scholarship to NYIT and during his basketball career, the Bears made it to the NCAA Tournament twice, losing in the championship game to Virginia Union in 1979-80. After graduating, Doughty became the academic advisor to student-athletes, and three years later, he became the Assistant Director of Athletics. In 1988, he succeeded Dr. William T. Lai as Director of Athletics.

Doughty currently oversees intercollegiate, recreational and intramural athletic programs at the Old Westbury and Manhattan campuses. He counts among his achievements enhancing the athletics department's organizational structure and stability, and improving the academic performances of NYIT's student-athletes. During Doughty's tenure, the Bears have made numerous appearances in NCAA and ECAC post-season play. The men's lacrosse team has won the NCAA National championship four times, 1997, 2003, 2005 and 2008, the ECAC Championship in 2001 and appeared in the NCAA championship game on two other occasions, 1994

and 2002. The men's basketball team captured the ECAC championship in 1995, while the men's track and field placed third at the NCAA Division II Outdoor Track and Field Championships in 1999 and second at the indoor championships in 2001.

Doughty, who earned a bachelor's degree in business management, has two master's degrees from NYIT: one in human resource management and one in human relations.

Doughty has served as chair of the Eastern Collegiate Athletic Conference's men's basketball committee, the men's basketball chair of the New York Collegiate Athletic Conference, and was a member of the NCAA's Northeast Men's Basketball Regional Committee for three years. He was president of the NYCAC from 1994 through 1997, and was a member of the ECAC's Executive Council from 1989 until 1992.

In January 2001, Doughty was named to a four-year term as a member of the NCAA Division II Management Council. The council implements policies adopted by the NCAA Executive Committee and the Presidents' Council, interprets Division II bylaws, and recommends the adoption of amendments and regulations regarding Division II athletics.

As part of his Management Council responsibilities, Doughty has served on two project teams and has been a member of the committees on budget and finance, championships, the Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC) and the honors committee.

In 2004, Doughty was selected by the National Athletic Directors Association (NACDA) as the Division II Northeast Region Athletic Director of the Year.

Doughty currently serves on the NCAA Student-Athlete Advisory Group within the student affairs division. The group supports NCAA staff in the areas of education programs, health and safety and leadership development.

During his tenure, Doughty has assisted in the development and implementation of the Bears Den fundraising club, the establishment of the Athletic Hall of Fame, the annual Bears Golf Outing, the Athletic Directors Honor roll, the BEARS mentor educational program, the Senior Awards banquet, the Bears Care Community Service program, and the Night Out on The Bears community engagement program.

"I am honored that I have been able to sustain a very fruitful career at NYIT," he says. "I have been blessed to work with great individuals who have taken the time to help me mature as an administrator, mentor, parent, and human being."

Doughty resides in Wheatley Heights, NY, with his wife, Pamela, his mother, Ida, and three children: 32-year-old Brandon, 24-year-old Jessica, and 20-year-old Andre.

## DIRECTIONS TO NYIT

## BY CAR

## FROM THE WEST:

Long Island Expressway (I-495) to exit 39N (Glen Cove Road). Follow Glen Cove Road north to Northern Blvd. (Route 25 A). Turn right onto Northern Blvd. and head east. The NYIT entrance is the third traffic signal on your right.

## FROM THE EAST:

LIE (I-495) to exit 41N (Route 107). Go north (toward Glen Cove) on Rte. 107 to Northern Blvd. (Route 25A). Turn left onto Northern Blvd. and continue west for four traffic lights. Make a left into NYIT's main entrance at the fourth traffic light.

## FROM THE SOUTH SHORE:

Take either the Meadowbrook, Cross Island or Wantagh Parkways north to the Northern State Parkway, exit 31. Make a left at light, proceed north on Glen Cove Road until you reach Northern Blvd. and follow the above directions.

## PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:

The Long Island Rail Road provides access at several stations: Hicksville, Manhasset and Greenvale (closest to campus). The Metropolitan Transit Authority's Route N20 bus, which travels from Main Street in Flushing to the Hicksville train station via Northern Blvd. stops adjacent to the main entrance of the campus.
